No Cost/ Low-Cost Substance Use Treatment Options

Billy Gregory/ Pine Street:

This is a state funded substance use facility out of Ft. Worth TX for adults. Phone intakes are completed every weekday morning starting at 8am, and the first 10 calls are taken. Callers that complete the phone intake will be informed what they need to do next for treatment. There is typically a waitlist. Treatment could start in a couple days or weeks, but the wait is no longer than a month.

Homeward Bound:

This is a state funded substance use facility out of Dallas, TX for adults. Intakes are done on weekday mornings starting at 7:30am. Intakes should arrive early to get in line outside of the building. This facility will only accept who they have room for, and doesn't quote bed availability. Potential patients need to bring an ID to complete the intake.

Turtle Creek Recovery Center:

Dual diagnosis (chemically dependent with need for psychiatric medications) inpatient treatment. Screenings for admission are Monday through Friday 7am to 11am in person at the facility. Admission occurs same day, no waitlist typically. Accepts North Star and other insurances. If no funding is available, then bed can be funded by the state. No Detox available. Treatment last about 2 weeks.

Nexus Recovery:

Beds available through state funding, but an assessment in person has to be completed. Facility needs last place of residence, a letter from person that has been supporting them financially, two bills with the supports name or clients name and residence, proof of income, and a Texas ID. Call to schedule an in-person assessment. Some additional cost may apply based on income. Beds are available for women, and pregnant women. There is also the possibility of women and their children attending as a family, who have no more than three children who are 11 and under in age. Adolescent **female** beds are for 13-17 years old, and the wait is typically short. In house education is run through Dallas ISD. **FEMALES ONLY.**

Volunteers of America:

This is an inpatient substance use treatment program for adult men and women in North Texas. Volunteers of America are a faith based nonprofit organizations committed to servicing people dealing with the issues raised by poverty in America and supporting populations at risk. Please call to speak to an intake coordinator. Substance use prevention and education programs are also available for children and adolescents who may be at risk. This is a free facility but must be sent by a judge or probation/parole officer.

Solutions of North Texas:

A deposit is required to attend, but scholarships are sometimes available. Attendees will be required to find employment, and eventually pay facility fees with their income. This is a "highly structured 12 step environment" per staff. Potential patient will need to fill out the housing application online and note that they don't have any funding at this time.

The Campus: A Place for Recovery:

This is a state funded facility for adolescent substance use. The inpatient facility has 16 beds and serves 13-17-year-old **males**. Outpatient program is available for male and females. To do an intake you must call to set up an appointment, and then do an assessment in person. May also serve 18yo if still in high school. Computer based education through Fort Worth ISD. **MALES ONLY.**

Phoenix House: Hill A. Feinberg Academy:

Inpatient substance use treatment for males and females 13-17 years old. This residential care includes counseling individually and with families, as well as groups. Adolescents in the program take part in Dallas ISD education and can take part in credit recovery. Costs are flexible and can be sliding scale based on income.

Sundown Ranch:

This facility specializes in providing care to adolescents and young adult's ages 12 to 24 years of age suffering from chemical dependency. They have the ability to deal with clients that also have a co-occurring psychiatric disorder. The program focuses on groups, individual, education, psychiatric services, and 12 steps and family counseling. Willing to work with sliding scale fees.

The Waterford Academy:

An integrated program that uses various forms of therapy, Peer Recovery, and other social support systems including AA and NA. Program has both partial hospitalization and outpatient for adolescent's ages 13-17 years old. School is conducted through online school. Contact to complete an assessment. Willing to negotiate fees or sliding scale.

Provides shelter and housing for up to six months per stay for recovering alcoholics and drug addicts at a minimal cost. We act as a liaison between our residents in need and service agencies that might fulfill those needs for continued treatment. Provides a place for 12-Step recovery groups. Provides an environment to make those who want recovery or want to support recovery welcome. Treatment fee for admittance is typically around \$350.

Billy Gregory Unit is Detox and Pine Street is the 15–28-day inpatient program. Detox includes a 20-bed facility that offers about 5 days of detox with 24 hour a day medical supervision. Inpatient program is a dual diagnosis facility with 50 beds that includes groups, individual counseling, and family counseling. May accept Denton County residents. Intakes occur in person or over the phone on weekdays. Phone intakes start at 8am on weekday mornings and they take the first 10 callers each day. Intakes can also be completed in person at the facility, and appointments are encouraged. Anyone attending the inpatient program will need to arrive with 45 days' worth of medications. Outpatient treatment is also available in a 15-day intensive program. There is typically a waitlist for treatment. For outpatient intake call the recovery resource council at 817-332-6329.
