Why Provide a Referral?

The COMPASS Program was created based off the evidence of the Recovery After an Initial Schizophrenic Episode Implementation and Evaluation Study (RAISE-IES) that was funded by NIMH. This research suggests the following finding:

- The sooner treatment is initiated after a first episode of psychosis, the more likely the person will experience recovery
- Overall improvement in symptoms and functionality
- Cost-effective treatment
- Reduction in hospitalization episodes and length
- Improved provider and client relationship and engagement
- Improved understanding of diagnosis and management for clients and support systems



Who is not eligible?

- Those experiencing psychosis due to substance use or withdrawal
- Those suffering from a traumatic brain injury
